Kyle Harper is Professor of Classics and Letters at his alma mater, the University of Oklahoma. He graduated summa cum laude with a degree in Letters from OU and then received his Ph.D. in History from Harvard University in 2007.

A historian of Rome, Harper is the author of three books, *Slavery in the Late Roman World*, awarded the James Henry Breasted Prize, *From Shame to Sin: The Christian Transformation of Sexual Morality*, which received the Award for Excellence in Historical Studies from the American Academy of Religion, and *The Fate of Rome: Climate, Disease, and the End of an Empire*, which has been translated into 12 languages. His next project is a history of infectious disease, from human origins to the present. His work tries to bring the natural sciences into conversation with the study of the human past.
